

SRCHA Green Rider Rules

SRCHA Green Rider: This is an “entry level class” designed to introduce the rider to the Limited “Boxing only” cow horse event to become acquainted with the basic reined cow horse skills in a competitive yet non- threatening environment. There are no restrictions placed upon horse ownership, breed, age, or training level. Riders may use any NRCHA, AQHA or NRHA approved bridle. Horses 5 years and under may be shown in a snaffle or hackamore and shown 2 handed. Bridle horses must be shown one handed. Once the program has been completed riders should have developed the skills necessary to compete in NRCHA events with knowledge, safety and confidence. Points accrue by adding points for anything over a score of 60 in both the reined work and the boxing. Example: The rider scores a 65 in the reining and a 67 on the cow, the horse and rider earn 12 points. Points will be maintained by the association (but encourage riders to track points as well). Buckles will be presented to the rider after he/she earns 200 points. Buckles will be presented at the year-end banquet, however the rider may continue to compete in this class for the remainder of the show year after earning 200 points. After the year has ended and a person has earned 200 points they will then move out of the Green Rider Class. The standard “Boxing Only” score sheet will be used in this class and all judging rules that apply to 5K Non Pro Limited apply to this class.
