



Directions from I-30 via University Drive to:

Equestrian Inspection Station (★): At the 2nd red light, turn west (left) on W Lancaster Avenue. Turn south (left) onto Gendy Street. At the 4-way stop, turn east (left) onto Burnett-Tandy Drive. (Gate 16) At the first intersection, turn right into the Tower Promenade. Staff will be checking health papers as noted below and doing a visual inspection of all horses arriving prior to directing you to stall assignments and the show office.

Entry Requirements as regulated by the Texas Animal Health Commission:

Intrastate (Equine moved within the state of Texas)

- A negative EIA test is required within the previous 12 months prior to entering.

Interstate (Equine moved into the state from other states)

- A negative EIA test is required within the previous 12 months prior to entering.
- Certificate of veterinary inspection within 30 days prior to entry.
