



Southwest Reined Cow Horse Association 2024 Stallion Service Donation

The Southwest Reined Cow Horse Association developed the SRCHA Stallion Service Auction to benefit its competitors, with 100% of the proceeds going toward the Aged Events awards and prize money for the following year. With its two major events, the Wild Rag Classic in May and the Pre-Futurity held in August at the Will Rogers Memorial Center, Ft Worth TX, stallion owners have two opportunities to promote their stallions for the current and upcoming breeding seasons at no cost to the stallion owner. *(Mare owner will be responsible for all chute fees, mare care costs and/or semen shipping costs.)*

In return for the exposure and promotional opportunity, the Southwest Reined Cow Horse Association requests one stallion service, to be donated for online auction beginning January 22 and ending February 4, 2024.

Stallion Owner Incentive ~

By participating in this stallion service auction, the stallion owner will receive the following at the 2024 event(s):

- 10 x 10" booth per stallion, on the John Justin arena concourse at the Wild Rag Classic and the Pre-Futurity.
- 30 second video, to be shown throughout the Pre-Futurity, featured on the live internet broadcast via Equine Promotions at the Pre-Futurity. (video to be provided by stallion owner/agent and received by event management by **July 15th**)

- 20" x 24" color stallion poster (produced by SRCHA) displayed in a SRCHA sponsored Stallion Booth on the John Justin arena concourse at both events. *Artwork to be provided by stallion owner or agent at least two weeks prior to the start of the event.*
